# LIFEJACKET HELPS GOLDFISH SWIM

A goldfish was diagnosed with an incurable illness called swim bladder disorder. The disease makes the fish more likely to swim upside down, float or sink, which are usually all symptoms a fish can correct after a few days if the illness is caused by digestive problems.

Stacey O'Shea, owner of the Garden Sanctuary in Wolverhampton, came to the rescue and made the goldfish a special lifejacket using tiny plastic tubing as well as polystyrene to weigh it down. By changing the size of the polystyrene occasionally, the much-loved goldfish was able to happily swim at different levels of its tank.

### BOY'S BOW TIES HELP RESCUE DOGS FIND FOREVER HOMES


14-year-old Sir Darius Brown has been making stylish bow ties for cats, dogs and their "hoomans" to help rescue animals get adopted faster.


A few ideas for places you could leave them; inside a book, on the kitchen worktop, in a pencil case, on a chair.




## Send A Hug

This 'handmade hug' is a perfect gift for a friend or family member you love and care about. You can send it through the post! Who would you like to send a hug to?

#### You will need:

Thin card (coloured or plain)
Coloured pencil or pens
Scissors
String
Stapler, Sellotape or PVA glue
Envelope and postage



#### Step 1:

Take your piece of card and draw around each of your hands.

#### Step 2:

Decorate each hand using coloured pens and pencils. If you like, you can write some words such as 'A hug from me to you.'

#### Step 3:

Carefully cut around each outline.

#### Step 4:

Now you need to cut a piece of string that is about the length of your arm span. (Your arm span is the length from the tips of your fingers on one hand to the tips of your fingers on the other hand when you stretch your arms out on each side.) You might need somebody to help you with this bit.

#### Step 5:

Attach a hand to each end of the string with a staple, tape or glue.

#### Step 6:

Your hug is complete! Place it in an envelope and ask an adult to help you stamp and address it then it's ready to go in the post.
